David Spell Deed to David Underwood for 164 acres land
 This indenture made this 18th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty eight Between David Spell of the State of North
 Carolina and County of Sampson of the one part and David Underwood of
 the said State and County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the
 said David Spell for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and
 twenty eight Dollars and fifty cents specie money, in hand paid before
 the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged and myself therewith satisfied contented and paid have
 bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain
 sell, convey, and confirm unto the said David Underwood his heirs
 and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land in the County of Sampson
 aforesaid and on the south side of little Bearskin Swamp containing one hundred
 and sixty four acres Bounded as follows. Beginning at a Stake on the corner
 of little Bearskin Swamp, David McKingys Corner. thence his line be 217
 94 poles to a Stake in John Underwoods line. Thence his line due east
 294 poles to a black gum on Bearskin Swamp thence up the run as it
 meanders about north 100 poles to four maples as pointers. thence due west
 62 poles to a hickory thence S. 40 W. 10 poles to a sweet gum on the side
 of the mill dam. Thence up the spring of little Bearskin as it mea-
 ders to the Beginning. To have and to hold unto the said David Under-
 wood, his heirs and assigns. And I the said David Spell for myself
